Trinny Scarf

YARN

Rowan Fine Lace

NEEDLES

1 pair 2³/₄mm (no 12) (US 2) needles

TENSION

31 sts and 48 rows to 10 cm measured over patt using 2³/₄mm (US 2) needles.

FINISHED SIZE

Completed scarf measures 14 cm (5¹/₂ins) by 176 cm (69 ins).

SPECIAL ABBREVIATIONS

sL2togK = slip 2 sts as though to K2tog; sL2togP = slip 2 sts as though to P2tog tbl; p2sso = pass 2 slipped sts over.

SCARF

First section

Using 2³/₄mm (US 2) needles cast on 44 sts.

Work in patt as folls:

Row 1 (RS): K1, *yfwd, K2, sL2togK, K1, p2sso, K2, yfwd, K7, rep from * to last st, K1.

Row 2: K1, *P8, yrn, P1, sL2togP, P1, p2sso, P1, yrn, P1, rep from * to last st, K1.

Row 3: K1, *K2, yfwd, sL2togK, K1, p2sso, yfwd, K9, rep from * to last st, K1.

Row 4: K1, *yrn, P2, sL2togP, P1, p2sso, P2, yrn, P7, rep from * to last st, K1.

Row 5: K1, *K8, yfwd, K1, sL2togK, K1, p2sso, K1, yfwd, K1, rep from * to last st, K1.

Row 6: K1, *P2, yrn, sL2togP, P1, p2sso, yrn, P9, rep from * to last st, K1.

These 6 rows form patt.

Cont in patt until work meas approx 88 cm, ending after patt row 6 and with RS facing for next row.**

Break yarn and leave sts on a holder.

Second section

Work as given for first section to **.

Join sections

Join last rows of both sections by either grafting the 2 sets of sts together, or by casting off both sets of sts together.

MAKING UP

Press.
